- 4 The readers will review only the five pages of responses to the Selection Criteria questions below
- 5 Up to ten readers per nomination category will comprise a review panel. They will select one nominee in each category to represent Rockford in the Illinois state IHOSE WHO EXCEL program. Important: State nomination forms are due on a date to be determined by the Illinois State Board of Education.
- 6 As the nominator you will be expected to introduce your nominee at the reception. It will be necessary to prepare a two-minute presentation describing the highlights of the nominee's educational service. Feel free to be comedic or entertaining

SELECTION CRITERIA

When reviewing and evaluating each nomination, readers will be looking for specific information and examples that answer the following five questions about the nominee's educational service and contributions to school and academic improvement

- 1. How has the nominee demonstrated excellence in the fulfillment of duties?
- 2 How has the nominee demonstrated concern for children?
- 3. What positive effect has the nominee had on the school environment?
- 4. How has the nominee shown leadership or inspired others to achieve?
- 5 How has the nominee achieved above and beyond what would be expected in the fulfillment of duties?

ADDITIONAL IMPORTANT INFORMATION

HISTORY:

The THOSE WHO EXCEL Education Awards Program began in the 1974-1975 school year as an expansion of the Illinois Teacher of the Year Program. It is a statewide program sponsored annually by the Illinois State Board of Education to honor individuals in public and nonpublic schools who have made outstanding contributions to the educational community. At the local level a standing committee was created to nominate local individuals for these state honors. Over the years, the committee has created a series of events that define the local THOSE WHO EXCEL program.

NOMINATIONS:

You must use this nomination form and you must be an employee of District #205. Attach (with a staple) in the upper left corner and return before the deadline. To be a valid nomination it must contain both the nominee's and nominator's signatures. The nominator can be multiple individuals but one person must be designated as the official contact person and all communications from the committee will be sent to that individual. Please keep in mind that this contact person will need to coordinate the building's involvement with the THOSE WHO EXCEL committee as the process moves from the reception to the local banquet, and on to the state banquet.

Please note: to be eligible for consideration for Teacher of the Year at the state level, nominees in the teacher category must also hold a teaching position in the fall of 2014.

RECEPTION:

There are 225 tickets available for the reception and these are distributed equally among the nominees at no cost. Due to preparation costs, no additional tickets are printed. After the nominee and nominator receive their tickets, each building needs to determine how its additional tickets are to be used (i.e. staff, family, friends). Normally there are 20 to 25 nominees so it is important that the two-minute rule for introductions is observed. Alcoholic beverages may be purchased on site but cannot be brought in due to insurance regulations.

BANQUET:

The banquet is held at Tebala Shrine at a cost of \$35.00 per person. A maximum of 450 tickets will be available. Two complimentary tickets will be available, one for the nominee and one for a guest. All other tickets must be purchased and seating will be available on a first come first served basis. Absolutely no reservations will be accepted after the published deadline (see calendar). Everyone who wishes to attend must have a ticket whether or not they decide to dine. In order to keep our costs down, we have contracted to have Tebala Shrine's caterer serve a specific two entrée meal. A single vegetarian option may be available. Alcoholic beverages may be purchased on site but cannot be brought in due to insurance regulations. Please do not cause problems by ignoring this agreement. Corsages/boutonnieres and table arrangements are not provided. If your school wishes to provide a table centerpiece, please be considerate of groups who may be seated behind you and do not bring objects that could block their view. All nominees are introduced and honored on stage. When the representative to the state is announced, he/she will not be asked to deliver a prepared acceptance speech but will be welcome to say a few words.

STATE:

State representatives will submit a more in-depth nomination packet to the Illinois State Board of Education. The state awards banquet is held in the fall and more information will be forthcoming.
